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Secondary Cycle II, Year III (Grade 11)

The focus of this course will be on creating the mindset needed to continue developing physical literacy throughout a student's lifetime. Students will work towards developing the knowledge, skills and attitudes to enable them to value, attain and maintain a healthy active lifestyle beyond high school. Students will also be evaluated on continually participating actively, effectively, safely and respectfully in a wide range of individual and group activities inside their classroom cohort.
